IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND RULES GOVERNING SINGLE REGISTRATION

Read and Follow All Instructions

1. All applications for Single Registration must be made on United Kennel Club, Inc., application forms, which are furnished free of charge. Completed applications will be not returned to you.
 2. All applications must be accompanied by proof that the dog is purebred. A copy of your dog's registration form issued by a registry acknowledged by United Kennel Club is normally sufficient proof of pure breeding. If you wish to inquire about the status of a registry, please contact the UKC Registration Department. Photos of your dog are not normally required but must be submitted if requested.
 3. If you cannot supply proof that your dog is registered with a UKC-acknowledged registry, attach a written explanation and two color photos of your dog, one standing in profile and one taken from the front. Photos must be sufficiently large (3" x 3" minimum) and clear so that our Single Registration Committee may fairly evaluate the dog.
 4. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
 5. United Kennel Club, Inc., Registry is a separate and distinct registry and has no connection with any other registry.
 6. The individual signing this application is solely responsible for the accuracy of the information contained therein.
 7. United Kennel Club, Inc., reserves the right to correct or revoke any UKC Registration Certificate or Pedigree at any time.
 8. Rules for single registration may vary depending on the breed of dog to be registered.
 9. Purebred dogs exhibiting UKC breed standard disqualifications will be denied registration but may apply for Limited Privilege listing. Limited Privilege dogs must be spayed/neutered and are only eligible for UKC performance events. Limited Privilege Gun Dogs are also eligible for Hunting Retriever events.
 10. United Kennel Club, Inc., reserves the right to refuse any Application for Single Registration.
