Our club is offering the convenience of entries with HuntSecretary.com. You can opt to register via US Mail by completing the premium and sending a check or take advantage of easy online entry and credit card payment. There will be a \$5 fee for entries made after the closing date 02/24/2012.

We will be hosting our test at the Tarrant Ranch in Bullard, Tx. Tarrant Ranch is just south of Bullard in the community of Mt Selman off of Hwy 69 between Tyler and Jacksonville.

Directions from Jacksonville:

Traveling North on Hwy 69 from Jacksonville – turn left on FM855. (There is a sign for the Killough Monument and a Texaco station on 69 directly across the street from 855) Take a quick right on CR3701 at the Methodist Church and follow 3701 approx. 2 miles to the test grounds.

Directions from Tyler:

Traveling South on Hwy 69 from Tyler – turn right on FM855. (There is a sign for the Killough Monument and a Texaco station on 69 directly across the street from 855) Take a quick right on CR3701 at the Methodist Church and follow 3701 approx. 2 miles to the test grounds.

Hunt Test Grounds: Stay on roads and do not create trails across pastures. Close any gates you open. Do not leave trash or cigarette butts at the test sites or any other areas. Please respect the landowner's property.

Our club will be offering lunches for purchase on both days of the test. There will be a tailgate dinner on Saturday evening and a raffle. Please support our club by staying for the raffle as this is how we make money to hold future events.

Our club will be offering mailing of ribbons for those who don't wish to stay for the ribbon ceremony. Fees will be \$10 for the first ribbon and \$5 for each additional ribbon. This fee is to cover the cost of envelopes and stamps.



There are several hotels on the south end of Tyler, which would be approx. 15 mi from hunt test site. None of them allow pets in the room.
